

House Regulations

- Works of art** must not be touched under any circumstances.
- Bags** up to size A4 (approx. 20 x 30 cm) may be taken into the exhibition, and must be carried in front of your body.
- Coats and jackets** may be worn but not carried over your arm in the exhibition.
- Umbrellas and sticks** Umbrellas must be left in the stands provided in front of the museum. Walking sticks are permitted in the museum, but only when fitted with a protective rubber tip.
- Photos/films** Photographing and filming in the museum are not permitted. Cameras may be deposited in lockers in the cloakroom.
- Writing/drawing** are permitted in the museum in pencil only. Please use a pad. Ballpoint pens, color and felt pens, brushes, scissors, etc. are not permitted.
- Mobile telephones** Mobile telephones must not be used, neither to telephone nor to take photographs.
- Baby carriages** Large baby carriages should be exchanged at the entrance for museum buggies. Small children must be held by the hand in the exhibition.
- Animals** No animals are permitted in the museum (except for seeing-eye dogs).
- Eating and drinking** No eating and drinking is permitted in the museum.
- No smoking** The entire museum is designated a no-smoking area.

Please help us to ensure the safety of the works on exhibit. The museum attendants are responsible for the security of the exhibits, so please follow their instructions. We appreciate your consideration and conformance with our house regulations.
